

OPERATOR SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Do Not Operate This Machine
Until You Read and Understand the
Following Safety Precautions.

1. Never operate this machine until you understand that this machine is dangerous and if you place your hands, clothes, or any part of your body in this machine it could result in the loss of fingers, limbs or even death.
2. Never operate this machine without the use of a guard, shield or safety device that will always protect you from bodily injury.
3. Always wear safety glasses, face protection or both and any other personal protection safety equipment needed when operating this machine.
4. Never wear clothing, jewelry or unrestrained hairstyles that will be hazardous to your own personal safety. When there are moving parts such as cutters, chucks, tables, etc., present, particular attention should be given to loose clothing and hair, neckties, finger rings, necklaces, watch bands, etc.
5. Always use hand tools for feeding or retrieving material from the point of operation or any other hazardous part of the machine. Never reach through or into a danger area for any reason.
6. Never operate this machine unless you feel you have been fully trained and have received and understand all operating instructions. Make sure you know how the machine works and how it is controlled.
7. Never operate this machine unless you are sure the safeguarding is adjusted properly and working correctly. If you are not sure call your supervisor.
8. Never operate this machine if it is not working properly or if you notice any unusual noise or change in the performance of the machine. Stop operating the machine immediately and advice your supervisor.
9. Always notify your supervisor immediately if you observe an unsafe practice or condition.
10. Always maintain an orderly work area. Particular attention should be given to the storage of tools or parts that could be dislodged and fall, or roll.
11. Never operate any motion of the machine with the wrench in the chuck. The chuck wrench should be removed from the chuck immediately after using it or a spring loaded chuck wrench should be used.
12. Never tamper with, alter, remove or disable any component or safeguard on this machine.
13. Any employee who adjusts, positions, or installs safety equipment, devices, guards, or shields should do so as instructed by the employer.
14. Always check the set-up during each shift and between each job to ensure all safeguarding is working and the operation will be performed in a safe manner. Severe operating conditions may require more frequent checking.
15. Be sure all persons are clear of the machine before it is powered, especially when multiple operators are present. Do not operate machine unless you and every operator and/or helper are protected from injury by a guard, shield or safety device.
16. Always stay alert (don't daydream) and never operate this machine while under the influence of alcohol or any other drug including prescription medications.
17. Maintenance and Set-Up Personnel: Never work on this machine unless power is off, rotating members are at rest, and all energy (electrical, air, hydraulic, etc.) are in a zero state.
